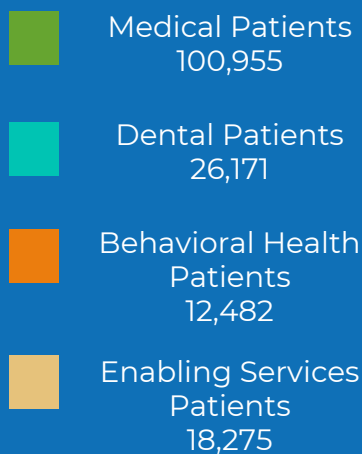

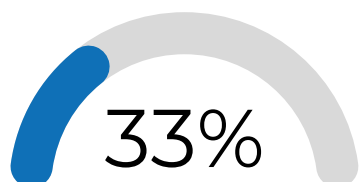

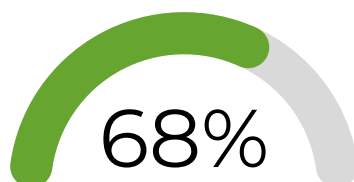

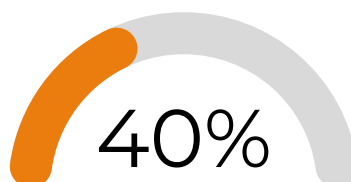
% of Uninsured Patients
